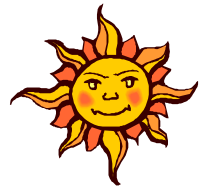

Both times the same questions entered my mind as a response, "What would you like from the organization?" " Why did you originally join the organization?" , "What did you get when you first joined , that you are not getting now?" and "What can I/we do as an organization, to renew your interest in being a member?"

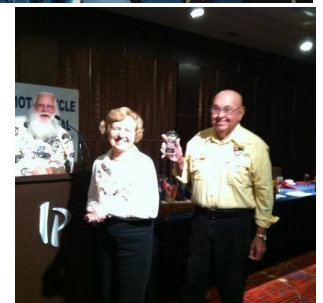

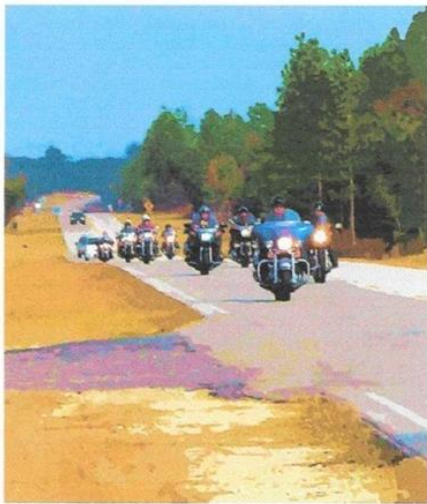

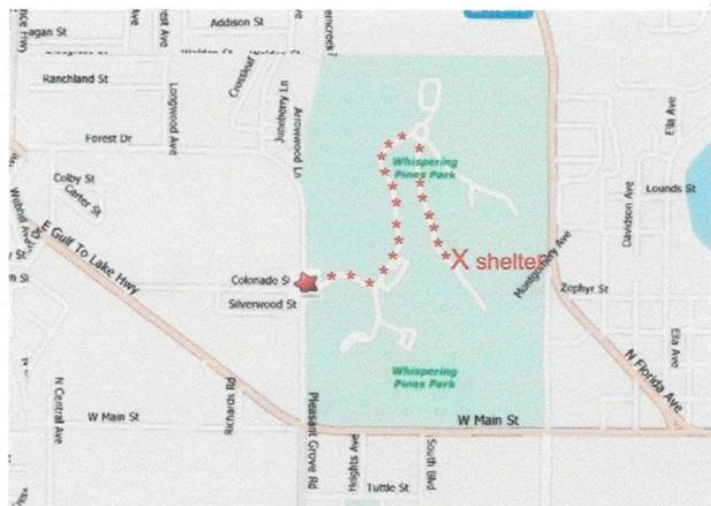
