Tallahassee NewsBy Janice Gargus

On one of our Thursday spring rides through the beautiful hills of north Florida, we drove through a very tiny community of Two Egg. Although all of us had heard about it, none knew how it got its name, *Two Egg.* Since it is interesting, here is the story from Bing.com:

The name might have lasted had it not been for the economic disaster of the Great Depression. Money dried up and jobs disappeared. Families struggled to survive and, as local cemeteries attest, hunger, malnutrition and sickness stalked the land.

By 1930, many local families were living on little more than pride. Unable to pay for items they needed in hard cash, they began to barter and trade with the storekeepers for the things they could not do



without. Two young boys came into the business so often on errands from their mother to trade two eggs for sugar that regulars jokingly began calling the establishment a "two egg store." The name caught on and was picked up by traveling salesmen and others who spread it to nearby towns.

The story may seem light-hearted on the surface, but at a deeper level it reflects an effort to put a good face on very hard times. Many local families then were barely surviving and at times of the year, when fresh fruits and vegetables were not available, sugar provided one of the only available sources of carbohydrates.

Two Egg is the childhood home of Academy Award winning actress Faye Dunaway.

For years, residents and visitors to the rural area have seen a strange creature in wooded and swampy areas, a "mini-Bigfoot" called the *Two Egg Stump Jumper.*


